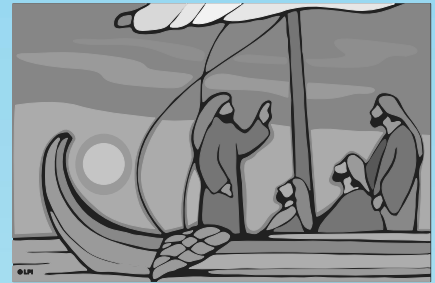

Bible Study / Gospel of Mark

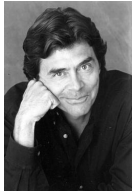

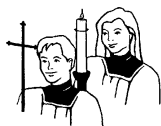
