Cycle's of Faith

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

When the 2002 World Youth Day in Toronto concluded, the lead organizer, Fr. Tom Rosica, CSB, embarked on a new endeavor with the encouragement of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. He, and some of the young adults who were crucial to the success of World Youth Day, began a Catholic television network in Canada. In July 2003, Salt + Light Television began broadcasting as a digital cable channel. Already a multi-year winner (2008 and 2009) of the Gabriel award for best television station of the year from the Catholic Academy of Communication Arts Professionals, Salt + Light Television has become a producer of solid Catholic programming that is recognized around the world. The television station takes its name, of course, from the section of Matthew's Gospel that we hear today. Last week's Gospel of the Eight Beatitudes was just the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount. We'll be reading from that part of Matthew's Gospel all the way up until Lent, and this week's Gospel follows immediately upon the beatitudes. It is important to have those in mind as we think about salt and light, both in the Gospel, and the television station as well.

As was mentioned last week, the beatitudes are the positive law for Christians. Rather than prohibitions against certain activity, the beatitudes are the way we are supposed to act. In performing the Eight Beatitudes, we become salt of the earth and light to the world. That's why Jesus could say let people see your good deeds. In the shows it produces, Salt + Light Television tells the stories of Christians living their lives in the light of Christ, doing good deeds and acting out of love. Living in that way is not always easy, as the shows reveal. But the station is true to its name, showing that Christians can be a light in this world.

We are currently on Group #1 of the funeral lunch group list. Work has begun on the new list and will be completed after the Christian Mother's meeting on February 15th. If you would like your name added or removed from the substitute list ONLY call Joan Sand at 845-2705. We could use a few additional volunteers for the substitute list :)

How does the Funeral Lunch group volunteer program work, you may ask? When a parish family member dies and in accordance with the families wishes, the assigned funeral group prepares and serves the dinner after the Funeral Mass. The parish is divided into 27 groups and the list typically lasts 12 to 18 months. New parish members are automatically added to the bottom of one of the groups. The three top families listed are the "chairpersons" for this printing/term and their names rotate to the bottom of the list. You will be asked to bring a cake, cookies or bars for the dinner—the substitute does not supply this. Ladies & gentlemen from each group are asked to help prepare, serve and clean up for a funeral lunch. If a family representative is unable to work when your group # is up it is very important to either exchange with someone from another group or make arrangements with a substitute. It is essential that the entire parish be involved in this parish service. If you are unable to come when your group number is up, please find a substitute from the ladies listed.

We realize a good number of you work and/or have small children, however by taking your turn (usually once every 18 to 24 months) you are giving a wonderful gift to the families who are in need of your help.
