**Cycle's of Faith**

**4th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

One of the units in junior high social studies curriculum is learning how a bill becomes a law. Basic governmental literacy rests on an understanding of the process, from the bill's introduction, through amendments and votes, to its final disposition for a signing or veto. We can all probably picture the chart that was in our textbook with the arrows that led the bill on different paths depending on the result of each step in the process. Even then, that chart was a simplified version of how things actually take place in the present legislative process.

The laws we're presented with in today's Gospel have very little in common with the laws that are enacted through legislation. The lawgiver in today's text is Jesus. He presents the beatitudes (and other laws, which we'll hear in the coming weeks) in the Sermon on the Mount. Matthew presents Jesus as the new teacher and lawgiver, now standing in the place of Moses who brought the tablets of the law—the Ten Commandments—down from Mt. Sinai. Jesus now gives the Eight Beatitudes as the law for the Christian life, a way of acting in the world. You'll hear a lot of people talk about the Ten Commandments as a basis for law. Even some Christian preachers will speak out about the necessity of having them posted in public places. Yet the New Testament, in Matthew's Gospel, makes it clear that there is a new law, a new dispensation, ushered in by Jesus who begins his own catalogue of commands with, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 5:3).

Like the recollection of that chart from junior high social studies, I suspect that most of us could get through reciting the Ten Commandments, at least by naming the subject of each one even if we couldn't recite them word for word. But how many of us can recite the Christian law: the Eight Beatitudes? ©2010 Liturgical Publications Inc

We are currently on Group #27 of the funeral lunch group list. Work has begun on the new list. If you would like your name added or removed from the substitute list ONLY call Joan Sand at 845-2705. We could use a few additional volunteers for the substitute list : )

How does the Funeral Lunch group volunteer program work, you may ask? When a parish family member dies and in accordance with the families wishes, the assigned funeral group prepares and serves the dinner after the Funeral Mass. The parish is divided into 27 groups and the list typically lasts 12 to 18 months. New parish members are automatically added to the bottom of one of the groups. The three top families listed are the "chairpersons" for this printing/term and their names rotate to the bottom of the list. You will be asked to bring a cake, cookies or bars for the dinner—the substitute does not supply this. Ladies & gentlemen from each group are asked to help prepare, serve and clean up for a funeral lunch. If a family representative is unable to work when your group # is up it is very important to either exchange with someone from another group or make arrangements with a substitute. It is essential that the entire parish be involved in this parish service. If you are unable to come when your group number is up, please find a substitute from the ladies listed.

We realize a good number of you work and/or have small children, however by taking your turn (usually once every 18 to 24 months) you are giving a wonderful gift to the families who are in need of your help.
