**Cycle's of Faith**

**17th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

When my father died, he left a garage full of stuff. Over several years my brother and I made several attempts at cleaning out the garage. While Dad was alive he resisted any efforts that we made at trying to eliminate some of the clutter. He was always fearful that we would throw out some treasure that he had managed to squirrel away in the cavernous three-car garage. After his death we set about the task of eliminating the stacked up boxes, salvaged metal, broken implements, and general junk. There was very little that was valuable and an awful lot that was worthless. The dragnet of my dad's retirement rummaging pulled in a lot that was thrown away.

The parable of the dragnet in today's Gospel can seem a bit heartless. The angels at the end of time act like those who sit on the seashore with their dragnets, separating the good from the bad. The wicked end up in the fiery furnace. While it's clear that the dragnet will be sorted out, good from bad, it's not so clear in the earlier parables who is who. Just who is that merchant searching for fine pearls? Is it the disciple, who seeks the kingdom of heaven and when he finds it he holds on to it with all his heart? Or is God the merchant, searching for those who have lived in accord with the dictates of the law? And when God finds them does he ransom them with the blood of his Son, giving all he has to secure their participation in the kingdom?

True parables are slippery things. They are not always singular in their meaning. The layers of interpretation can be multiple, which is part of the richness of their truth. For my dad, much of what was in the garage was treasure, while for his sons a lot of it was to be thrown out. It's probably good that God doesn't clean out his garage too often.
