**Cycle's of Faith**

**29th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

While anyone with a paycheck ends up paying taxes regularly, there are many others who pay their taxes as a quarterly estimate. Many states or provinces have a sales tax that applies to certain goods and services. Even some local municipalities add their own fraction of a percent on top of that. And anytime we put gasoline in our car we are paying taxes. Benjamin Franklin's adage, "In this world nothing can be said to be certain, except death and taxes," is certainly true for any of us in this country. It could be said that we are rendering to Caesar by way of the taxes we pay as part and parcel of our everyday life.

In the Gospel today Jesus points out that there is nothing wrong with paying taxes. In fact, in the examination of conscience in the Rite of Penance, the questions that are asked include, "Have I done my duty as a citizen? Have I paid my taxes?" From the perspective of a Christian, paying taxes is part of promoting the common good, since government exists to foster and protect society. Encouraging development and promoting the common good are causes that the popes from the time of Leo XIII to the present have particularly supported in their encyclicals and reflections. And it is an idea that is occasionally lost in the heated political rhetoric of North American culture. As the popes have highlighted, the "common good" is an especially Christian ideal, since it means that we are attentive to the needs of all in society, an inclusive and wide-reaching perspective on who the community truly is.

If paying taxes-and in that way promoting the common good-is already a part of our everyday life, we might want to ask ourselves in what ways repaying to God what belongs to God is taking place in our lives every day. How taxing is our spiritual life? Or is our spiritual tax rate too low?

## New Translation of the Missal begins Nov. 26-27

Frequently Asked Questions (# 1 of 10)

### #1. Why was there a need for a new translation?

The Missale Romanum (Roman Missal), the ritual text for the celebration of the Mass, was promulgated by Pope Paul VI in 1970 as the definitive text of the reformed liturgy of the Second Vatican Council. That Latin text, the editio typica (typical edition), was translated into various languages for use around the world; the English edition was published in the United States in 1973. The Holy See issued a revised text, the editio typica altera, in 1975. Pope John Paul II promulgated the third edition (editio typica tertia) of the Missale Romanum during the Jubilee Year in 2000. Among other things, the third edition contains prayers for the celebration of recently canonized saints, additional prefaces for the Eucharistic Prayers, additional Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Intentions, and some updated and revised rubrics (instructions) for the celebration of the Mass. To aid the process of translation of the Missale Romanum, editio typica tertia, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued Liturgiam Authenticam, in 2001, an Instruction on the vernacular translation of the Roman Liturgy which outlines the principles and rules for translation. In 2007, the Congregation for Divine Worship issued the Ratio Translationis for the English Language, which outlined the specific rules for translation in English.
