

Service Hour Information

There is no full list of what can be done for service hours, but here are some suggestions.

- ***Church hours** can consist of working for Pioneer Days if they are working for Holy Family School (HFS). If they work for someone else, it can be community hrs.
- *It is considered Church hours for Catholic Aid breakfast and any breakfast for HFS and the Faith Formation Program. They usually happen in Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, & March
- *Working for a funeral dinner.
- *HFS has a carnival in February.
- *The Soup supper (Ash Wed)/croissant fundraiser
- *Church cleaning and decorating.
- *Helping to change prayer books in church. This usually happens the middle of Oct.
- *Sister Alice often has project also, and sometimes HFS need help with things.
- *The day of the church Bazaar along with the 4 days of set up and prep work before the bazaar and clean up day on the Monday after.

- ***Community hours** can be volunteering at the nursing home.
- *Helping at the Senior Dining Center.
- *Working for the Legion Bkf, or putting flyers on vehicles for them. They have one in Sept and one in Feb.
- *Heritage Days
- *Sometimes the Library asks for kids to count people as they enter.
- *Volunteering at sporting events or other school events.
- *Volunteering for Community Education programs.
- *Volunteering for fundraisers.
- *Helping with blood drives.
- *Helping at shelters.
- *Helping with community projects.
- *Helping an elderly person in need, while not receiving pay. (Jobs to be done can be found on a card on the Ministree located in the parish center. Please return the signed card to Joan Sand's office.)
- *Picking road ditches.

- *Things that **don't count** are babysitting for someone. (Not a community project)
- *Working for your parents or grandparents. This is something you should be doing anyway. Helping your family should come naturally.
- *You cannot count time for serving, ushering, greeting, lecturing, taking up gifts, or singing in the choir. It is our obligation to go to mass and participate.

30 hours are required total. Between 15-25 hours should support our parish.
