

St. Anthony Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes

May 17, 2011

I. The meeting of the St. Anthony Parish Pastoral Council was called to order at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, May 17th. Father led the Council in prayer.

II. Members present were David Stueve, Sandy Wielenberg, Marlene Ramacher and Father. Also attending was Ralph Stich.

A. Property Lines: There has been some discussion with St. Anthony Village members, Father and the Parish Trustees regarding the church and personal property lines within the Village. The cost for a Quit Claim Deed, updating the Abstract and recording a New Plat could be up to as high as \$1100. Father and the Trustees will pursue the necessary requirements so that the correct property lines are noted for insurance and tax purposes.

B. Religious Ed: Marlene announced that she will step down from the Religious Ed Coordinator position. She is now working full-time (previously had not been when she took the position), and has family obligations that need to be met, so is unable to spend the time necessary for the position. The Council thanked Marlene for her years of service and Father will look to fill the position.

C. New Lawnmower: A new lawnmower was purchased for the parish by Goebel Dairy. With all the rain, Ralph has had a chance to enjoy its use quite often already. Thank You, Goebel Dairy!

D. Maintenance: The sidewalk that runs towards the west of the main steps is in need of repair. Ralph has an estimate of approximately \$1300 that would also include the removal of the old concrete. The woodwork on the parish house needs to be repainted.

E. Finances: The Financial Report was passed out and met with the approval of those present.

III. The meeting was adjourned at about 8:15 p.m.
